



## **Evidence Technician**

The Douglas County Sheriff's Office (KS) is accepting applications for an Evidence Technician

This position will perform non-commissioned technical work collecting, analyzing, documenting, and preserving evidence from crime scenes; conducting laboratory analyses of evidence; reconstructing crime scenes; and testifying in court about findings and methods. This position will also support evidence room functions as needed; inspection of forms and item packaging; moving, storing, and assisting in court ordered destruction of items, research of case dispositions, interaction with public, data entry, complete a variety of other basic clerical tasks; and to provide information and assistance regarding department policies and procedures.

Preferred experience 1-3 years in a law enforcement agency working with evidence, 5 years' experience in crime scene investigation; bachelor degree in forensic science, the natural sciences or related field; or significant experience in a law enforcement setting may substitute for bachelor degree.
